If you closely look at abalone fillet, you will find three stomas. These are the blood vessels of abalone. The blood of abalones is hemocyanin, which is copper-protein, and it flows out little by little from the damaged location, gradually discolors the nacreous layer to brown. Furthermore, this causes the mantle to detach from the abalone, resulting in its death.
